STEP 1 - GET THE APPLICATION PACKET

STEP 2 - FOLLOW THE APPLICATION PROCESS

Complete the forms and send them, along with the \$100 application fee, to your district superintendent for his approval. The district superintendent will assign a coach to oversee your studies.

STEP 3 - GET STARTED

Upon approval of your district superintendent, the district office will forward the forms and fees to the Church Leadership Academy. As soon as you are enrolled, we'll send you a copy of the Student Handbook, containing instructions and links for registering for courses.

- The applicant is morally and spiritually acceptable to serve in your congregation and minister to you.
- The applicant is respected in the non-Christian community, as well as in the church, and is known as one who pays her/his debts.
- The congregation should be willing to support the applicant in his/her studies through your encouragement, prayers, and if necessary, financial assistance.
